### **Moore Class Trip to The London Eye and River Cruise– Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> November.**

We have booked a Moore Class geography field trip to **The London Eye with a River Cruise** to support our learning in geography this term about Villages, Towns and Cities.

We will be catching the 9:12am train from Sevenoaks train station to London Waterloo East and then have a short walk to The London Eye Pier. We therefore would be grateful if parents could make arrangements to drop children off at Sevenoaks train station **by 9:00am**.

The trip will include: observing the River Thames from above; taking to the Thames with the award-winning London Eye River Cruise. This 40 minute cruise features educational live commentary presented by expert guides and includes sights such as St Paul's Cathedral, Tower Bridge, Tower of London and Shakespeare's globe.

An approximate timetable for our day is:

10:00 Arrive and collect tickets from the London Eye Pier Ticket Office

10:20 Arrive at the London Eye Pier to await boarding for the London Eye River Cruise (Arrival for boarding is recommended as 20-25minutes in advance of our ticket time)

10:45-11:30 London Eye River Cruise experience

11:30-12:15 Lunch at the Southbank Centre

12:15-12:30 London Eye 4D cinema Experience (Depending on time)

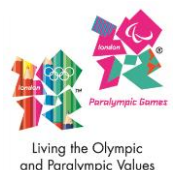
12:30-13:45 London Eye boarding line, security check and Standard Experience (Subject to queue time)

We plan to catch the 2:38pm train back to Sevenoaks which arrives at Sevenoaks at 3:01pm. We would be grateful if parents/carers could make arrangements to collect their children from Sevenoaks Train Station at 3:12pm.

On the day, children will need to bring a small snack and a packed lunch plus their water bottle in a named small back pack to make it easier to carry, but please leave book bags at home. We are a nut free school so please ensure that you do not include any nuts.

You are required to complete a consent form for this event; this will give permission for your child to attend and for the teacher in charge of the party to give consent on your behalf for any urgent medical treatment, including anaesthetic to be given.
