Dear Parents and Carers,

4 Week Sailing Course for Four Year 5/6 Pupils

I have been offered the opportunity to secure **four places** on a local sailing course for Year 5 and 6 pupils.

The school will cover the cost of the course. Please see details below:

It will run for four weeks on Tuesdays from 3.15-6.30pm, on:

Tuesday 3rd June

Tuesday 10th June

Tuesday 17th June

Tuesday 24th June

- Participants would commit to attend every session and need to arrive at 3.00pm
- All pupils will gain the level one sailing qualification
- Parents would need to arrange transport to and from Chipstead Sailing Club and would need to be part of a rota of parents with the other participating schools who would commit to providing on shore cover (this would probably only be once for the four-week course). Parents must attend for the first 15 minutes of the first session to hear all about the club's policy's and the four week course and organise the rota
- The school would fund this course from the Sports Funding so there would be no fee payable
- All participants will be required to complete a medical form

The course would include provision of instruction, sailing dinghies and buoyancy aids. The children would have to have their own suitable attire and footwear (at this time of year a shortie wetsuit is advisable, a light rain jacket, and non-slip shoes e.g. old trainers, plus a towel and change of clothing, a snack and drink).
