Dear Parents/Carers

<u>Moore Class Trip to: Southwark Cathedral Religion in Roman Britain Trail and the Making Mosaics</u> <u>workshop – Tuesday 8th October</u>

We have booked a Moore class trip to a Religion in Roman Britain and Making Mosaics Workshop on Tuesday 8th October, at Southwark Cathedral, London to support our learning this term about Roman Britain.

We will be catching the **9:33am** train from Sevenoaks train station to London Bridge and then it is a short walk to Southwark Cathedral. We therefore would be grateful if parents could make arrangements to drop children off at Sevenoaks train station by **9:15am**. If you are unable to drop your child for this trip you will need to make your own arrangements with another family. Please let the school know if your child will be travelling with someone else.

When we get to the Cathedral we will be doing an interactive Religion in Roman Britain Session exploring what and how the Celts and Romans worshipped as well as the rise of Christianity in Britain and Europe 250 years later. The session includes dressing up, making headdresses and a sandbox dig. They will also learn about the Roman artefacts discovered on the site of Southwark Cathedral during archaeological work, 40 years ago. We will then have lunch at 12:00pm before the afternoon art and design workshop in which they will design and make their own mosaic. We will return to London Bridge train station to catch the 14:54pm train back to Sevenoaks. This is due to arrive at Sevenoaks Station at 15:19pm. Please could you make arrangements to collect your child from Sevenoaks Station or if you are unable to do this yourself make arrangements with another family.

On the day, children will need to bring a small snack and a packed lunch plus their water bottle in a named small back pack to make it easier to carry, but please leave book bags at home. We are a nut free school so please ensure that you do not include any nuts. School uniform and school caps must be worn please.

The cost of this trip will be £13. **All payments must be made online** at www.scopay.com/shorehamvillage by **Tuesday 1st October**. If we do not hear from you by this date then we will assume that your child is not able to participate.

You are required to tick the consent box for this event, this will give permission for your child to attend and for the teacher in charge of the party to give consent on your behalf for any urgent medical treatment, including anaesthetic to be given.

















You will also need to indicate who will be transporting your child to the station. We request that if you are unable to drop or collect your child at the venue that you make your own arrangements with another family to transport your child.

We will be looking for volunteers to help with this trip so please indicate on the form if you would be able to.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind parents that if you need help with payment for this event, please write to Mrs Lovatt-Young who will consider the application for support on a confidential basis.
