### Harvest Service and Remembrance Service – Cameron Class volunteers required

As part of our work of Character Education, we encourage pupils in Cameron Class to volunteer to represent the school in two local events.

The Harvest Service at St Peter and St Paul Church in Shoreham is an opportunity for one or two pupils from Cameron Class to read a piece of work they have created or to share a chosen piece of poetry or narrative as part of the church service on Sunday September 27<sup>th</sup> at 10am. The theme is usually around gratitude for what we have and we will help the children write or choose an appropriate piece to share.

On Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November at 10am, two pupils are invited to volunteer to carry the school wreath to the church, read a chosen passage or poem and then process to the War Memorial to lay the wreath on behalf of the school. We will help the children write or choose an appropriate piece to share.

There is no need whatsoever for any pupil involved to have Christian beliefs as our contribution is about being active citizens in our community. For both events, the children need to be taken to the church for a prompt 10am start and a parent or carer will need to stay with them. There is a brief dress rehearsal for the Remembrance Service on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> that can be attended if possible.
